Gretchen Ward recently retired from a 35-year career as an archaeologist, park ranger, and cultural program manager with the federal government. She is a past president of the San Diego Epiphyllum Society and has been raising epiphytic plants for most of her life, ever since her mother bought her first epicactus hybrids when she was just a kid.
