in 2014, 290 plants entered: 182 cacti, 108 other succulents in 2013, 343 plants entered: 237 cacti, 106 other succulents; in 2012, 412 plants entered: 264 cacti, 148 other succulents; in 2011, 414 plants entered: 282 cacti, 132 other succulents

in 2010, 320 plants entered: 164 cacti, 156 other succulents
